Steps for enrolling

- Complete an enrolment form two months before your child turns 5 years old.
- You are welcome to come into the office during school hours to pick up an enrolment pack. Alternatively, you can download the electronic copy from our website www.anchoragepark.school.nz
- The following documentation will be required at enrolment:
 - 1. Child's birth certificate or passport.
 - 2. Copy of your child's immunization record.
 - 3. If you are not a NZ citizen you will need to bring your child's passport containing their residency or student visa.
 - 4. Proof of Address tenancy agreement, power or water bill, rates account, bank statement, etc.
- Transition to School Visits are every second Wednesday morning (9:00 – 10.15am). Please contact the school office to arrange a visit.





Steps for being school ready

We focus on learning social as well as academic skills and attributes.

Set your child up for success by practising the following skills at home.

Build social skills:

- Taking turns
- Following simple
 instructions
- Take part in everyday experiences
- Participate in conversations with family and friends
- Identify emotions eg talk about how they are feeling
- Build resilience

Show readiness to learn:

- Know how to write
 own name
- Know letter names of the alphabet
- Count to 10
- Know some shapes
- Hold a pencil correctly
- Use scissors safely

Grow independence:

- Look after own property
- Put shoes on independently (Velcro shoes are best)
- Get changed independently (useful for swimming lessons)
- Use playground equipment safely
