# NAG 2.4:

## **RATIONALE:**

The Parent Teacher Association (PTA) plays an integral role in parent liaison, fundraising ventures and events that benefit the school and the children.

#### **PURPOSES:**

- To foster goodwill through organising events for the school's community.
- 2 To organise fundraising that will supplement the school's operational grant and include the purchase of designated items of equipment as approved by the Board.
- To organise the activities in such a way that social or financial returns reflect the hours committed by the members.
- 4. To promote positive communication between home and school.

# **GUIDELINES:**

- The PTA will meet regularly (usually twice a term) with the election of officers and committee members at the February / March meeting.
- 2 The Principal and / or another Board member will attend each PTA meeting.
- The PTA has the delegated authority to fundraise on behalf of the Board of Trustees.
- The PTA, through the Principal, will consult with and seek approval from the Board of Trustees for each year's proposed fundraising ventures.
- 5. All income and expenditure will be recorded and reported as part of the Board of Trustees monthly financial reporting.
- 6. The PTA Treasurer (or Principal) will present a financial report at each PTA meeting.
- 7. PTA income and expenditure is recorded in the Board of Trustees Annual Financial Report as part of the school's locally raised funds.
- 8. PTA Meetings are to follow parliamentary guidelines with the keeping of accurate minutes, correspondence, financial report, Principal's report and General Business.
- 9. The Board of Trustees will provide the PTA annually with a statement of accounts.
